Cheyney's fortune Oak-smoked Cheddar - Godminster, Bruton

Cheyney's Fortune Oak-Smoked Organic Vintage Cheddar is made using the same cheese as the Vintage Bruton Beauty organic cheddar before being delicately cold-smoked over sustainably-sourced oak chippings for the perfect smokey aroma. This delicious cheddar has won many awards.

Morn Dew-White Lake, Bagborough Farm, Shepton Mallet

This semi-hard cheese has a stunning and vibrant colour, made from Guernsey cow's milk and boasting a delicately creamy, soft and spongy texture.

Guinevere Buffalo - Somerset Cheese Company, Ditcheat, Shepton Mallet

Guinevere Buffalo Cheese is made with rich and creamy buffalo milk. Being around 3 to 4 months old Guinevere develops a well-rounded, nutty flavour with a close, dense texture that is milder and less lactic than a cheddar. Tasty, but easy on the palate. The name Guinevere is from the legends that surround Glastonbury.

Black sticks blue – butlers cheese, Wilson fields farms, Preston (Not somerset – but so damn good!)

Black sticks blue is creamy, smooth and delicious – but with just enough blue bite to get your tongue tingling!

Glaston tile - White Lake, Bagborough Farm, Shepton Mallet

Glaston tile is a firm, fresh and creamy goat's cheese which is incredibly versatile. Beautiful on its own, but equally delicious in sweet and savory dishes. Made with unpasteurised milk and vegetarian rennet

Deep purple ruby colour. Nose of black woodland fruit, dark cherry and plum with some hint of exotic wood
Walter Hicks Western Hunt Ruby Port – 5.40 100ml, Btl (75cl) 40
Lush, ripe, full bodied port with soft tannins and fresh red berry flavours
Taylors 10 Year Tawny Port – 7.5 100ml, Btl (75cl) 50
Long & rich, little creamy
Taylors 20 Year Tawny Port - 12 100ml, Btl (75cl) 75
Medium-bodied and silkily-textured, but rich and complex in flavor.
Elderberry Port – 6.50 100ml A port like drink made from English red wine, wild elderberries and Cornish brandy
